

Roses



Belle Poitevine Rose

Rosa 'Belle Poitevine'

Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Belle Poitevine produces large, semi-double, medium-pink blooms about 3 inches across. The blooms are recurrent, blooming in early summer until frost. This rose is mounded, about 4 feet high by 4 feet wide.



Blanc Double de Coubert Rose

Rosa 'Blanc Double de Coubert'

Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Low maintenance, Own Root, Zone 3

This is a white, recurrent rose with neat rounded growth and leathery foliage. With full sun this rose will grow to 5-7 feet in height, and 3-5 feet in width. The flower is full and about 3 inches across.



Charles Albanel Rose

Rosa 'Charles Albanel'

Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

A smaller Explorer rose, Charles Albanel blooms with clusters of double mauve-red flowers about 3 inches across. Fragrant and recurrent, resistant to disease, this rose produces orange-red hips along with orange and yellow fall foliage. A good, small garden rose, Charles Albanel will grow to 2 feet by 3 feet.



Dart's Dash Rose

Rosa 'Dart's Dash'

Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

The 3 inch to 4 inch flowers of Dart's Dash bloom repeatedly from early summer to frost. This is an extremely fragrant rose. Autumn brings orange-red hips among the lingering blooms and dense orange fall foliage. Dart's Dash will grow to 3 feet by 4 feet.



David Thompson Rose

Rosa 'David Thompson'

Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

David Thompson starts flowering in early summer with deep pink buds opening to fragrant, fuchsia blooms. The double 2.5 inch to 3 inch flowers bloom freely throughout the summer on a 3 foot by 4 foot dense bush. This rose has few thorns. It is highly resistant to blackspot and powdery mildew.



Dwarf Pavement Rose

Rosa 'Dwarf Pavement'

Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This light pink rose is fragrant, semi-double with 2.5 inch to 3 inch flowers. The Dwarf Pavement rose is exceptionally salt tolerant, and so, useful near roads and driveways. At 2 feet to 2.5 feet, its small size and compact form makes it a very good rose for the front of the garden.



Foxi Pavement Rose, Buffalo Gal Rose

Rosa 'UHLater'

Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This rose is recurrent with deep pink flowers and glossy light green leaves. The flowers are fragrant and appear in late spring and continue to frost. The flower is semi-double and opens to 3 inches across. The hips in fall are bright red. This rose grows to 4 feet by 4 feet in full sun.



Grootendorst Supreme Rose

Rosa 'Grootendorst Supreme'

Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrance light to strong, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This rose is recurrent and produces clusters of dark red blossoms with serrated petals from mid Spring to mid Fall. Its flowers are double and open to 1 inch. The foliage is leathery and light green, with upright growth and very thorny canes. It prefers full sun and will grow to 4 feet high by 3 feet wide.



Hansa Rose

Rosa 'Hansa'
Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Hansa is a vigorous rose with recurring, deep crimson-purple blooms. Hansa flowers in May and repeats throughout the summer and producing large scarlet hips in the fall. The flowers are full, opening to 3 inches across. It has medium green foliage and an upright vase shape. It can grow to 5 feet high by 4 feet wide in full sun.



Henry Hudson Rose

Rosa 'Henry Hudson'
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 2

Henry Hudson is a semi-dwarf shrub that grows 1.5 to 3 feet in height and has a diameter of 3 feet. Its flowers are white with a pink tinge, double and cupped when open, with a fragrance of clove. This rose has tough, deep green foliage, and works well as a low bedding plant. It is very healthy, and very hardy.



Henry Kelsey Rose

Rosa 'Henry Kelsey'
Climber, Disease Resistant, Fragrance moderate, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Henry Kelsey is a hardy climber with glossy green foliage. Medium red flowers occur freely and repeatedly through the summer. The flowers are full and open to 3-4 inches. The canes will grow to 8 feet and more with full sun. It can be used as a climber or a very large specimen plant.



Hope For Humanity Rose

Rosa 'Hope For Humanity'
Shrub, Disease Resistant, Fragrance slight, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This rose has 2 inch, dark red, double blooms, from late June to late September. In full sun Hope for Humanity will grow to 3 feet tall by 4 feet wide. Cane strength is good to support flowers. The fragrance of these flowers is slight and disease resistance is good.



Rosa 'Jens Munk'
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This rose has a spicy fragrance with double, medium red blossoms, reaching 2.5 inches to 3 inches across. A large bush, the Jens Munk rose will grow to 4 feet to 6 feet tall. In the fall the foliage turns to shades of orange and yellow with bright red hips.



John Cabot Rose

Rosa 'John Cabot'
Climber, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

The John Cabot rose blooms in early summer until frost with rosy pink flowers. These 2.5 inch flowers are double and fragrant. This rose has vigorous canes and soft green foliage. It will produce orange hips in the fall.



John Davis Rose

Rosa 'John Davis'
Climber, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

The John Davis rose has leathery, glossy foliage, with clear pink blooms opening to 3.5 inches. This rose has a spicy fragrance and will repeat later in the season. The John Davis rose has 8 feet long red canes which can be trained on a trellis or allowed to form a wide, arching mound.



Magnifica Rose

Rosa 'Magnifica'
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

This rose has recurrent mauve blend flowers without the need of continual dead-heading. The flower is double and opens to 3 inches. The Magnifica rose produces large orange hips in fall and can grow to be 4-6 feet high by 5-7 feet wide.



Marie Bugnet Rose

Rosa 'Marie Bugnet'
Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Marie Bugnet (Boo-Nay) has recurring, white flowers early in the spring until frost. They are double and open to 3 inches. The leaves are rugosa like but hardly veined, fairly smooth, and light green in color. Stems are red with no hips. This rose is a small rose, growing to 3 feet by 3 feet.



Purple Pavement Rose

Rosa 'Rotesmeer'
Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own root, Zone 3

This rose has crimson purple flowers, recurring throughout the season. The flowers are semi-double, opening to 3 inches with showy golden stamens. This rose is mounding with bright green foliage and scarlet hips in autumn. It will grow to 3 feet high by 3 feet wide and prefers full sun.



Redleaf Rose

Rosa rubrifolia, Rosa glauca
Shrub, Disease Resistant, Fragrance slight, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 2

This unusual rose has reddish violet stems and red leaves with very few thorns. Vase shaped, it can reach 5-6 feet by 5-7 feet in full sun. The once-blooming flowers are many in late spring, each is a small single, only 1.5 inches. Abundant orange-red hips ripen in fall and usually persist well into winter.



Rugosa 'alba' Rose

Rosa rugosa 'alba'
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 2

This rose is similar in all ways to the Rugosa Rose. The recurring, clear white single flowers will open to 4 inches across. The flowers give way to deep bright orange hips in August. The medium green foliage of summer changes to orange and scarlet in fall.



Rugosa Rose

Rosa rugosa
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Low maintenance, Own Root, Zone 2

This rose has mauve flowers that are single, recurrent, and 3.5 inches across. This plant does best in full sun but will tolerate part sun and poor soils. Orange to red rose hips form in late summer. Wrinkly (Rugose) leaves are glossy green and go to red in the fall. The plant will grow to 4-6 feet high by 4-6 feet wide.



Snow Pavement Rose

Rosa 'Schneekoppe'
Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Snow Pavement has pink buds that swell to semi-double blooms, opening to 3 inches. The fragrant flowers are white with a mauve pink tinge. Blooms are produced all summer. The foliage is healthy, dark green, and dense. The bush grows 2.5 to 3 feet with a low, mounded shape.



Therese Bugnet Rose

Rosa 'Therese Bugnet'
Hybrid Rugosa, Disease Resistant, Fragrant, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

Therese Bugnet produces mauve pink blooms all season long. They are full, opening to 4 inches, with a papery texture and a mild, spicy fragrance. Extremely disease resistant, the gray-green foliage is held on almost thornless stems. The foliage turns deep red in fall and dark wine red canes contrast against the winter snow.



William Baffin Rose

Rosa 'William Baffin'
Climber, Disease resistant, No Fragrance, Hardy, Own Root, Zone 3

William Baffin has long vigorous canes to 10 feet and is an excellent hardy climber. It has deep pink blooms in clusters of up to 30 blooms, recurring all season. The flowers are double and open to about 2.5-3 inches but have no fragrance. The foliage is glossy green.
